BIRMINGHAM INTERNATIONAL TATTOO

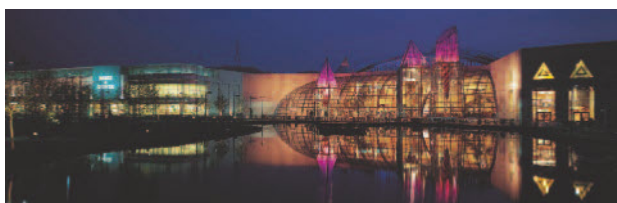

THE OLDE TYME PLAYERS CHRISTMAS SPECTACULAR



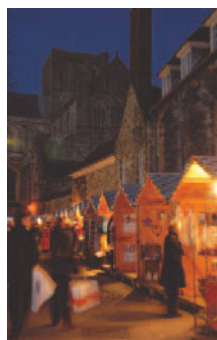
