

SATURDAY 2ND OCTOBER

DISCOVER BRUGES FOR A DAY WITH EUROTUNNEL



Depart Oxted 6.30am (Route A) for Folkestone to board Eurotunnel for France, then on to Bruges, capital of Flanders, where canals carve their way through rows of ancient buildings, cobbled streets, ancient churches, gates and bridges. Visit the lace and chocolate shops, or simply relax in one of the many pavement cafés before returning to Calais to board the Eurotunnel. Arriving back at Godstone approx. 9.15pm. (Passport required.)

Please note that the coach park is on the outskirts of Bruges with an approx. 20 minute walk alongside the Minnewater to reach the town centre.

SUNDAY 3RD OCTOBER

PADDLE STEAMER PARADE ON BOARD WAVERLEY



Depart Oxted 7.45am (Route C) for the drive to Tower Pier, London where we shall board Waverley, the last sea-going paddle steamer in the world. Our cruise takes us down the River Thames (see Tower Bridge open just for us!) via Tilbury and Southend, then into the Thames Estuary before cruising the River Medway. Here we shall be joined by the Edwardian Paddle Steamer Kingswear Castle and Britain's only working Paddle

Steamers will cruise up the river with flags flying and sirens sounding. On board, stroll around the promenade sun-decks, visit the self-service restaurant, relax in the comfortable lounges and see the magnificent steam engines and paddle wheels working. A souvenir shop sells postcards, sweets and guide books, and a ship's post box will mail your postcards, franked with the ship's own hand stamp! Refreshments available. We return to Tower Pier by 7.45pm for the journey home. Arriving back in Sanderstead by approx. 9.00pm.

We shall then enjoy a 2 course supper – Beef & Spitfire Ale Casserole and Sticky Toffee pudding. Return leave 10.00pm. Arriving at Godstone approx. 11.00pm.

BOAT CRUISE VIEWING THE QUEEN ELIZABETH'S DEPARTURE ON HER MAIDEN VOYAGE



Depart Oxted 10.00am (Route A) for Haskins Garden Centre on the outskirts of Southampton where there will be time for lunch and a browse before making our way to the port for the 3.30pm boarding/4.00pm sailing of our Blue Funnel Cruises boat viewing the Queen Elizabeth as she sets sail on her maiden voyage. The Queen Elizabeth recalls the rich heritage of the first Cunarder to bear the name. Her elegance both echoes that legendary age and enhances her luxurious modern allure. The ship has 16 decks, 12 of which provide accommodation for just over 2,000 passengers. At 90,400 tonnes she is the second largest ship ever to be unveiled by Cunard and the third new ocean liner to have been introduced by them in the past six years. Joining Queen Mary 2 and the Queen Victoria they will once again have all 'three Queens' sailing together. There will be light refreshments available to purchase on board. Return leave 6.30pm. Arriving back at Godstone by approx. 8.30pm.

Depart Oxted 7.00am (Route A) for the Eurotunnel. From Calais we make our way to the Ypres area, visiting the German cemetery at Langemark and Tyne Cott, the largest commonwealth cemetery in the world. The "In Flanders Fields" exhibition (entry not included) reflects the moving picture of the destruction of Ypres town and the misery and

distress felt by soldiers and civilians during the war. See the Menin Gate, the most famous of all war memorials. There will be time to enjoy an evening meal (cost not included) before, at 8 o'clock, experiencing the haunting strains of the Last Post. Returning to Godstone by approx. 11.00pm. (Passport required).

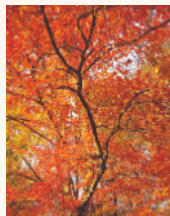
