### Taunton

All rooms in this modern hotel feature independently operated air-conditioning. Following an extensive refurbishment, the majority of rooms now have walk-in showers. However, a small number of rooms have baths, these are subject to availability. The hotel has an indoor swimming pool, sauna and Jacuzzi.

### Friday 16 November

Departing Oxted we travel to Cirencester for the regular Friday Corn Hall antiques fair, where you will



find an eclectic mix of antique furniture, jewellery, silver and collectables. After time for lunch we drive on to Tetbury, well known for its range of antiques and other specialist shops; from toys to cheese, jewellery and clothing. Late afternoon we continue on to our Taunton hotel, arriving early evening.

#### **Saturday 17 November**

This morning we make our way south to the Westpoint Exhibition Centre, where you will find up to 400 stands, with a mixture of dealers from all over the UK and the West Country, offering an extensive range of antiques & collectables to suit every pocket. Leaving Exeter after lunch we make a stop in Honiton to check out the antiques centres and then make a final stop at the Trading Post Antiques Centre at Tytherleigh near Axminster before returning to our hotel.

#### **Sunday 18 November**

Departing after breakfast, we make our way to the Dorchester Curiosity Centre where you may find some hidden treasures. Housed in a 12,000sq ft warehouse, there are approximately 100 traders selling a broad range of products and styles. The cafe serves delicious home-cooked hot and cold food and cakes. From here we continue our homeward journey, maybe seeking out some other antique emporiums and local Sunday village fairs where so often bargains are to be found and arriving back in Oxted early evening.
