### Monday 28 May

Departing Oxted we make our way to Stamford, for our morning coffee stop. We continue our journey north to Thirsk, a lovely old-fashioned market town, best known as Darrowby in the well-loved TV series, All Creatures Great and Small. Here we shall be free to find a late lunch before visiting the World of James Herriot located in the 1940s period house that was the original practice of James Herriot, at 23 Kirkgate, known as "Skeldale House" in the books. Late afternoon we make our way to our hotel.



### Tuesday 29 May

This morning we visit delightful Castle Howard, one of Britain's finest historic houses and home to the Howard family for more than 300 years. Best known for its starring role in 'Brideshead Revisited', it also featured in the hit ITV drama 'Victoria', when the house doubled as Kensington Palace. Friendly and knowledgeable guides are on hand to share stories of the house, family and artwork as you explore at your own pace, admiring its awe-inspiring architecture, interiors and world-renowned collections. Take time too to enjoy the sweeping vistas, lakeside terraces, woodlands, temples, statues and formal gardens. Early afternoon we drive to York, where we shall be free to explore before returning to our hotel.

### Wednesday 30 May

After breakfast we make our way to Harrogate, where we shall spend the morning before the short drive to the RHS Harlow Carr Gardens, one of England's most relaxing and innovative gardens at the gateway to the Yorkshire Dales. We return to the hotel late afternoon.

### Thursday 31 May

A nice scenic day out today, commencing with a drive to Pickering where we shall have a little time to look around before boarding the North Yorkshire Moors Railway for a ride across the moors to the historic seaport of Whitby with its ruined cliff top Abbey overlooking the harbour. There will be time to explore the town before enjoying spectacular views of the area as we return to the hotel via Hutton-le-Hole and Helmsley.

### Friday 1 June

Taking our leave of the hotel, we make our way to Belton House, Grantham, often cited as being the perfect English country house. Here we shall have time to explore the fine collections in the house, enjoy the gardens and find lunch. Early afternoon we continue our homewards journey, arriving back in Oxted early evening.



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
